This is Monday morning but I guess I will write a few lines while Lizzie is eating her breakfast. went yesterday a great day. we planed to go over on the mountain if it was nice and warm but it was anything but nice Ella and Ira was going with us. the woods is so pretty snow that it would have been a nice time to go. Lizzie was very disapointed. Ida is getting a long well and is very comfortable

Preston dont like it becaus the baby
isnt a girl. Blanch went home sick
and Mrs Pike came down to work
in her place. she was vomiting and
of course they think something is
the matter with her. Charles and
Deal was here to dinner the day
you went away she was sorry not
to see you & think by what she said
that Draxy may be in the same fix
you are she isnt sick but she
hasnt seen anything for five
months the Dr told her she was all
right that there wasnt anything the
matter so they dont say much about
it Deal says she would be awful
worried if she didnt think that

was the matter she is doing lots of work putting up corn and beans and pickles you ought to hear Deal tell how hard Draxy works I shouldn't think there would be anything left for the other kids. I hope you are feeling as well and getting along nice with your work you will get your pickles all made before you know. My but isn't it cold this morning I wonder if you are washing
