June 23, 1912

Dear Marion -

I got your letter and box last ^{night} what was it some of the treat I thought perhaps you had a treat for your school and had some left over it was good anyway

I guess your peas are ahead of ours but I have had radishes for three or four days. Well Marion Grammie has made up her mind to come down. Lizzie is coming and wants Foss or I to meet her in Bangor so he will go down next Friday and Grammie can go with him and you can meet her in Bangor so she wont

have to go alone and when she comes
back you can come with her.

Foss has hired a man he is
coming the first of July. It is
Israel Levetts brother Mell Levett
but Hugh will stay untill after
hayring I think that is we expect
he will. his girl is sick now over
to Hights. Marion and Myron have
gone to Gilford and there is nobody
to take care of her Hugh stayed all
night and has gone back this
afternoon. It is to bad I hope she wont
be sick long she is so far from home.

George Perkins and Dara Foss
was married last wednesday night.
They have hired Ivas farm for a
year and Aunt Ella and I am
going to camp out up to Shirley
for a while. They went yesterday
they are going to fish and hunt and

have a good time how long do you think they will stay. Isa wanted me to go up and stay two weeks and he would bring me back.

Ella expects to get lots of strawberries have you seen any yet they are beginning to get ripe some folks have had a mess but I havent seen any yet. you can come up after your peas are gone ours will be good by that time. this is a nice day I suppose you are to church this afternoon you ought to be thankful that you live so near. three men some days this week
