Ludwig Backlund; Resident 67 Years

Funeral services for Ludwig N. Backlund of 160 Chestnut St., former owner of Backlund Stairbuilders and Millwork in Montclair, will be held tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock at Meyer and Lundquist, Inc., 100 Valley Rd. Mr. Backlund died Tuesday night at home after a long illness. He was 84. Burial will be in Mt. Hebron Cemetery.

Born in Sweden, Mr. Backlund came to the United States at the age of 17. He was a resident of Montclair from that time until his death, also spending part of the last six years in Avon. He was owner of the Backlund Stairbuilders and Millwork on James St. for 40 years until his retirement in 1941.

He leaves two sons, John L. Backlund of the home address and Edward N. Backlund of Montclair.
